

Review of: "Oral Health Related Knowledge, Attitude And Behavior Among Group of Mothers In Relation To Their Primary School Children's Oral Health, Jeddah, Saudi Arabia: A Cross-Sectional Study"

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A very well written paper for a well conducted research ,however I have some comments:

First: why nearly the same number of students were sampled from private and public schools rather than withdrawing a sample with proportional allocation from Jeddah schools since it is well known that the number of private schools is almost half the number of public schools ,I think there was over representation of private schools in the sample.

Second :the Hiroshima inventory questionnaire includes mixed questions ;some indicate mothers 'attitude ,others express the attitude of professionals providing the mothers with dental care and some questions relate to self related oral health therefore I don't think that it could be wrong answer to say that I worry about visiting the dentist or about the color of my gums and it should not lower my score to say that I was not taught by a professional how to brush my teeth this should be regarded as a wrong professional's not mother's attitude. Therefore I don't think this questionnaire reflects sensitively mothers 'attitude towards their children's oral health .
