You may wish to break this paper into three different ones. Having three research questions is a lot. I think you will be better served if you go into more depth.

I struggled to see which research conversation you were targeting. I would probably do a more in-depth literature review, which will make your contribution clearer as well.

The method almost seemed like a survey - you did some "erklaeren" but not enough of the "verstehen". I suspect you have rich interview data - you showed some of it. I would build your method and findings around this data - then weave it together to show a coherent picture of Nigerian education.

The paper also seems prescriptive - I think you should perhaps leave the advice piece for the discussion and conclusion and focus more on using the rest of the paper for description.

Again, this paper is off to a great start, and I hope to have the opportunity to review the next version. Good luck!
