- 3. The "Results" section does not explain the impact of the COVID-19 challenge on student learning outcomes and mental health as stated in the research objectives in the "Abstract" section.
- 4. The "Discussion" section has not compared this research with relevant previous research.
- 5. The "Conclusion" section does not answer the purpose of this study.
