

# Review of: "Prevalence of Common Mental Illness and Its Associated Factors among Hawassa City High School Students in Hawassa, Sidama Region, Ethiopia"

The work is quite good, and mental health issues are relevant worldwide. Some observations can be made using a p-value threshold of 0.25. I do not know if there is a typo, or really, you have taken this threshold. If there is no typo, why did you take it? Alternatively, the real threshold was 0.025. The other observation is the statistical power; it is clear that you have a large sample, but how much power do you have? It is possible to report a post hoc statistical power analysis. For the rest, I think it is a good contribution to mental health in countries outside the USA and/or Europe.
