The authors claim that a variety of problems, particularly those pertaining to maternal and reproductive health, can result from migration. It may also have positive outcomes. This belongs in the Introduction section; thus, it should be moved.

The main research finding concerns the concept that internal migration and mental health status are bivariately correlated. However, when hierarchical logistic regression accounts for other linked covariates, this correlation vanishes. Two other details that should be included are the model fit for regression analysis and the total variance explained by the model. When the corrected copy becomes available, I'd be happy to read it.
