

Review of: "A Bibliometric Review of CSR in China Based on CNKI Database: 2006-2022"

The paper entitled "A Bibliometric Review of CSR in China Based on CNKI Database: 2006-2022" conducted a bibliometric review of the CSSCI journal literature on China Knowledge Network from 2006 to 2022 by using the CiteSpace, with the aim to examine the status and trends of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) research in China. Overall, the paper is written with a clear logic flow and the findings contribute to our knowledge. Please consider the following comments and suggestions to further improve the quality of this manuscript.

Introduction: The current Introduction section reviewed the history of CSR, including the origin of CSR, the evolution of CSR, CSR in the World and in China. The authors may want to make the Introduction more relevant to their research. For example, what is the research question, why it is important to have this bibliometric review, what are the unique characteristics of CRS in China, etc. To change this general introduction to a more specific introduction, the authors can highlight the purpose and value of their research.

Data and Methodology: More information is needed for this section. For example, Is China Knowledge Network the same as CNKI (China National Knowledge Infrastructure)? Was CSR the only keyword used in the advanced search? The keyword was CSR or Corporate Social Responsibility? How to decide the level of relevance to CSR? How the CiteSpace was used to conduct bibliometric analysis?

Some minor comments: the tile in Figure 1 is not clear; the format of Table 1 (e.g., the size of rows) should be updated; please proofread the paper to avoid some writing issues.
