I believe that this article is a significant contribution to the mathematical modeling of evolution, allowing for a formal distinction between micro- and macro-evolution that reveals the essential difference between the two. Of the minor shortcomings of the work, I would note only some repetitions in different parts of it. The Introduction, for example, repeats the Abstract almost verbatim. The elimination of such repetitions would allow the text to be shortened and make it more coherent. In general, however, I would like to congratulate the authors on an excellent, very informative, and promising study.
