Impact Analysis: While the paper addresses an important aspect of climate change and its correlation with wildfires, it lacks, in my opinion, a methodology description for the assumptions and conclusions extracted from this study.

Likewise, some other reviewers posted in the open discussion forum that the incorporation of additional references and performing a more rigorous evaluation, complemented by visual data representations, would significantly strengthen the paper's overall impact and credibility.
