Dear Author(s), First of all, I would like to thank you for your research on the important subject of road traffic accidents, known as a prominent problem in all societies, especially developing countries. Your manuscript title is clear, and the introduction describes the main idea and significance of the study; however, the introduction seems too long. The literature review is also clear. I highly recommend you to rewrite the FINDINGS, as most parts of the RESULTS include some facts nor your results; also, some phrases such as "Many officers collecting RTC data lack adequate training" and "Inadequate resources are allocated to data capturing and recording" are not clear; actually, the meaning of "many officers" or "inadequate" is not clear. Actually, most parts of your FINDINGS should be written in the CONCLUSION, not as RESULTS.
