Very interesting topic of the article.

However, it contains many errors in the preparation of the text:

- 1) Introduction: here are freely selected literature sources and quite old ones. There is also no indication of the research gap. The only valid paragraph is the one describing the purpose of the research.
- 2) Methods: this is a synthesis of the description of the methodology. There is no detailed description of the planned and conducted research. From this fragment, you can actually learn little but then compare the assumptions with the results of the research.
- 3) Results: well described, although cross-sectional conclusions could be shown in relation to other studies or literature sources, which are missing in the introduction. It is not possible to determine the novelty of the conducted research
- 4) Conclusions and discussion: here too we do not learn much about the intentions of the authors and the limitations of the research.

In conclusion: an interesting area of research should be emphasized, but the presented text is still a draft requiring refinement to be called a scientific text.
