Review of: "Clausewitz's Conceptual Relationship Among Tactics, Strategy, and the Conduct of War (Kriegführung)"

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The text thoroughly analyzes Clausewitz's innovations in the notions of strategy and tactics and the combination of the two. The paper is appreciated for its careful and thorough philological and source-related reconstruction of the debate of the time concerning the two categories of tactics and strategy.

It is well written and has a remarkable bibliography and apparatus of notes.

What perhaps could have been developed more in the text is an in-depth study related to the conduct of war today, the use of the two concepts today, and thus the value, even today, of Clausewitz's insight. All this appears superficially hinted at only in the last lines of the text.
