The six species for which stock investigations were carried out were covered in depth in the research. The introduction did not really address the significance of these species. Beyond that, the study's aims are not really clear. The introduction has to be changed because it was written in a more brief manner.

Including a map of the research region is advised. When fish specimens are taken from landing centers, there will be a problem with the gear's selectivity. It is not recommended to use a one-year study for stock assessment; data from more than two years should be used instead. It is necessary to make improvements to the discussion section and cite more recent studies. This paper, in my opinion, needs a significant revision.
