- 1- After the summary, you must put the Keywords of the research
- 2- Follow one of the structures of a scientific article:
- OPERA: observation, problem, experimentation, results,

actions

• ILPIA: introduction, literature, problem, implication,

future

- IMReD: Introduction, Methodology, Results and Discussion
- 3- Clearly identify the research objectives at the end of the introduction and not before the conclusion
- 4- Clearly identify the methodology used
- 5- Even the author's own results and contributions are neither well understood nor clearly identified. There is not even a comparison between the author's results and previous works
- 6- The bibliography is ordered. However, it is neither rich nor updated (it is 2024). Furthermore, there must be more theoretical work on this issue. This must be completed.
