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This article is particularly well-written, exceptionally well-organized, easy to understand, and very thought-provoking. The author highlights the frequency of developmental regression in autism, which is not well known, and offers an explanation for this phenomenon, providing appropriate references to support this theory. It is especially interesting to relate both poles in the range of intellectual ability within the autism spectrum to a single underlying mechanism. The author may want to consider adding a section explaining any limitations and/or areas of future research that may contribute further evidence to support the assumptions and conclusions of the article.
