I very much appreciated this cleaned up and tightened version of the paper. The general thesis appears more clearly, and the points made are more concise and easier to delineate. It remains an ambitious work, attempting to identify and support a number of different "mental" phenomena via the quantum paradigm, and all in all, it does so effectively. My only remaining critique remains with the "proof" section (a little circular) and in projecting forward to future topics, including free will. The paper already tackles a number of quite disparate topics related to 'mind,' some quite convincingly. I am left with a question: regarding the idea of information being transmitted through a 'collective,' overriding, universal field, does this imply that we are born with some inherent "knowledge"? Some more than others? All in all, despite coming from a very different area of study, I have found the application of quantum physics as used in this paper to be interesting and enlightening.
