I believe that 800 deaths per week is a significant number and possibly similar to that found during the most severe months of the COVID-19 pandemic. Still, how does this number compare with the pandemic peak experienced in Italy?

I recommend an improvement in the description of the objective of the article. Is it an analysis, a prediction, or both? The description of this important milestone for the article should be improved.

Materials and Methods:

The language used can be significantly improved.

The equations could be presented using mathematical notation.

Results:

Do you not have access to information on sociodemographic characteristics to improve results? Presenting the increase and discussing it is essential. However, it is just as important to discuss and identify which were the most vulnerable populations, what the characteristics of this population were, etc.

These sections can be significantly improved by incorporating more results.
