If the author keeps efforts on improvement, here are parts of my suggestions.

1. It's better to combine Table 1 and Table 2 into one table.
2. It's necessary to display the details of models 'M1', 'M2', 'M3', including the variables involved, and meaningful elaborations.
3. The discussion should be the most important part of this research. Considering at least two parts: (1) statistical meaning of selected variables with different methods, (2) neurological meanings of selected variables in models.
4. Lots of papers in the reference list were not mentioned in the main part of this paper. I'd like to show them where were quoted and referred, or remove them from the reference list because of nonrelated.
