

Review of: "Internal migration and mental disorders among the adult population: a community-based cross-sectional study in Nepal"

Abstract: The abstract is too long. The authors could give up some phrases from the background, instead completing with the Conclusion section. The maximum number of words must be 250. The Future Tense should be replaced with the Present Tense or Past Tense Simple.

Introduction: It is necessary to be more systematized (e.g., mental health disorders/anxiety and depression).

Methodology: There is no need for so much geographical data about Nepal. It is necessary to better structure the section referring to "Sampling and sample size."

Discussion: There is no link between the prevalence of mental health disorders in the general population during the COVID period and the present study. The discussion about age must be placed after the health condition, and the relationship between the status of "migrant" and the presence of mental health disorders should be placed at the end.

The English language should be revised.

One of the weaknesses of the study is the accuracy of evaluating the presence of mental health disorders by answering the question "Ever been told by a doctor/healthcare worker you have depression and anxiety."

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
