

Review of: "Exploring English Communication Teachers' Perception of TBLT: A Case Study of B. Tech. Classroom Practice in Indian Engineering Colleges"

The research topic is interesting and the paper is well structured overall. However, the introduction contains a lot of irrelevant information (e.g. elaboration on various foreign language teaching methods, except for the communicative method which is relevant for this paper).

To clearly identify the research gap and be able to compare the results of other research to the ones presented in this paper, I believe the authors should review more papers that are specifically focused on issue at hand (*attitudes* towards implementing TBL at university level, especially at technical colleges), and possibly provide more information on whether or not this method had been already implemented by the respondents prior to their responses to this questionnaire.

I believe the results of the study should be discussed in more detail. Therefore I suggest that the current Conclusion section is split into Discussion (focusing on elaborating the results of the survey and their comparison to other research) and Conclusion, which would focus on the indications of future work resulting from this study and suggestions pertaining to teaching practice based on the results of this survey (these are at the moment completely missing).

The paper would also benefit from some (minor) editing, especially for style, repetition and punctuation.
