Yet No definite proof for long term physiological data after ARM surgery are available, But many points yet need to be addressed

- 1. There is no actual comparison between two groups of ARM treated by two expert groups to validate the comparison
- 2. They need to provide data regarding the proper histology of the fistula regarding the muscle and wall not just the epithelium as compared to normal anal canal
- 3. The study design and results could not provide explanation of their hypothesis and aim
- 4. Many references are old and not updated with little evidence
- 5. Some systematic reviews and metaanalysis need to be added
