## Abstract

It is a very interesting topic that analyzes Socio-cultural factors influencing women empowerment. However, the author(s) needs to address some minor as well as major issues.

- i. The methodology (Econometric Techniques) used in this study is missing.
- ii. Originality/ value of this paper are completely missing.
- iii. Policy implications are completely missing.
- iv. I suggest that the author(s) needs to revise the abstract carefully.

Introduction and literature

- i. This section is comparatively a smooth and more understandable reading.
- ii. The author(s) needs to add a few lines about why West Bengal, India are selected.
- iii. The author(s) needs to add findings in second last paragraph of introduction.
- iv. The author(s) needs to summarize the previous studies to build the research gap.
- v. Try to divide the literature in sub sections if it is possible.
- vi. There should be hypothesis at the end of each sub section of literature.

## Methodology

The author(s) has tried well to explain the methodology. But it would be good to mention the references from the literature in the measurement of variable section.

I believe that these comments will help the author(s) to improve this paper.
