It seems that the events related to positive or negative climate changes, natural disasters, and soil degradation have happened mostly in arid and semi-arid climates. These climates are mainly in poor countries or developing countries. In fact, the positive effects of scientific studies and environmental measures in developed countries may be less evident in this article. If you find during your research that these changes are more common in developing countries, you can make changes to the title of the article.

In some cases, you have mentioned Covid-19 as an environmental disaster. This seems to be doubtful, or at least it should be called a man-made phenomenon that will have destructive human and biological effects.

Also, some corrections are needed regarding the way of writing the text. For example, paragraphing will help to better understand the subject and not tire the mind while reading the text. The writing of some terms should be re-examined, such as soil density.

The shorter the sentences, the better. Some sentences have several lines that make reading difficult.

Some of the words in the sentence are written in capital letters.

Some words or sentences may be repeated several times, for example, the word "meanwhile" in a paragraph.

Abbreviated words must be written in full, and their abbreviations first, such as nitrous oxide and CO2, ...

Full descriptions of abbreviations in figures and tables should be written as fig/tab subtitles.



Recheck the format of the article according to the guidelines of the journal.
