However, to enhance the quality and impact of this paper, several key areas could be improved:

- Clarity and Accessibility: It is important to enhance the clarity of the paper. To make it more accessible to a wider audience, providing English translations for non-English examples or content would be beneficial. This will ensure that readers who are not proficient in the specific language used in examples can fully understand the context.
- Literature Review: The current literature review section is insufficient. To establish a stronger foundation for the proposed solution, it is essential to present and discuss relevant works related to the research (example: https://ieeexplore.ieee.org/abstract/document/10148893). This will not only provide context but also demonstrate how this study fits into the broader academic discourse.
- In-Depth Discussion of Results: The results section should be discussed in greater depth. Authors should not only
 present the findings but also provide a more comprehensive analysis and interpretation of the results. This can involve
 exploring the implications of the results, comparing them with previous research, and discussing any unexpected or
 noteworthy findings.
- Limitations and Future Work: Drawing on the existing literature and the results obtained, the authors should dedicate a section to discussing the limitations of their study. This should encompass any constraints in data collection, model choice, or other aspects of the research. Additionally, offering valuable insights for future work based on the study's findings will contribute to the paper's overall quality.
