Thank you for addressing an infrequent and well-referenced topic. That said, I am sad to be unable, after reading the paper, to reach a clear conclusion about how to adapt the activities for ASD individuals. The sensorial and motor profile of ASD people is not taken into account at all (or nothing is said about that), and the criteria of the psychological responses are not given. The paper would benefit from specifying many concrete pieces of information (who completes the questionnaires, how many ASD persons practiced the activities, what their profiles were...) to help understand what can be generalized. I encourage you to pursue, structure, and detail your data. It should be really interesting after that.

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
