The article puts the reader into the context of the subject. The aim and objective are well explained. The methodology is well explained and enables replication. However, the incorrect English grammar confuses the reader. I was unable to understand the findings and where the SEM results were documented.

The paper demonstrates an adequate understanding of the relevant literature in the field and cites an appropriate range of literature sources related to the study itself.

I believe this paper starts off well but the English language is confusing at times. Also, I am not sure if it is me that understood badly, but I can't see any workings of SEM.

I must be missing something here. I believe that this paper needs some major revisions to explain better why SEM was mentioned and to arrange the English language (By a native English speaker).
