The provided review article "Nanocarriers for protein and peptide drug deliver" has dedicated to investigate diverse nanoscale drug delivery platforms for proteins and peptides. The overall quality and novelty is good with simple but enriched conceptualizations. However, there are some comments to improve the visibility and quality of this work.

- 1_ The word "drug" can be eradicated from the title.
- 2_ Although the variety of nano delivery systems have been discussed, there is a lack of comparison between these systems, which should be added by preparing the pros and cons of these systems either in the main text of each section or as a comparative table at the end of each section.
- 3_ The visibility should be enhanced by designing an appropriate graphical abstract and adding related figures for each nano delivery platform to clarify the system organization and justify the predominant delivery mechanism of the peptides and proteins.
- 4_ Be aware that this article demands comparing more similar research articles in a certain section before publication (in my opinion).
