The authors elaboate on a wide-spread and important medical topic.

The objective of the review has not been stated.

Although various important aspects of the TCS withrawal/abuse problem have been highlighted the scientific message and conclusions remain somewhat blurred.

Since the scope of the article is TCS in prescription medicines, OTC products, and cosmetics used in very different health care systems and geographies it is difficult to get to take home messages. It would be easier to make firm conclusions when focusing on prescription medicines containg medium to highly potent TCS only.

Some statements lack a reference and can are thus not been considered scientifically valid.

It is not clear how the cited literature has been identified. Has the published literature been comprehensively considered?

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
