

# Review of: "Recent Trends and Techniques in Landslide Hazard Assessment"

Dear Authors,

I regret to inform you that, in my opinion, your submission, as it is, is not worthy of publication for several reasons.

First, the title is really ambitious, creating expectations of a critical review about the most recent topics debated in the recent literature worldwide. Unfortunately, nothing of this is included in your paper. You just give some very general comments about this topic, more suitable for a scholarly textbook than for an original scientific publication.

Although the title suggests a general overview of the topic, figures 1 and 2 (this last also of very bad quality, as Figure 4) are exclusively related to India. Moreover, no information about the criteria adopted for tracing Figure 2 is given.

My suggestion is not to attempt a general overview, but to propose a completely revised version of your work focused on the India case. A tentative title could be: "Recent Trends and Techniques in Landslide Hazard Assessment in India: a brief overview". In doing this, you should examine recent publications on the topic, individuating the findings of general interest arising from these publications, and presenting them under a critical perspective useful for similar applications in other areas.
