However, it seems more logical to include Figure 1 in the methodological process for the review of the studies. In addition, as a suggestion, if this conceptual review and classification process (based on 3 main criteria) can be added with bibliometric analysis or graphical expression, the classification and evaluation process related to keywords can become more valuable.

In addition, it is important to include the narratives in the limitations section together with the methodology narrative in terms of the progress of the initial study as a whole and to achieve narrative integrity.
