In general this was an interesting and well-written article. However, there are a few areas in which this paper could be improved before publication. For example:

- The introduction is quite long and repetitive, e.g. there were several uses of the phrase 'it was reported' - it could be made more concise in areas. It would also be useful to see some stats on the prevalence of mental health problems in students
- I would like to see more detail on how the qualitative analysis was conducted e.g. were themes decided collaboratively by members of the research team?
- You include information identifying the University in the table outlining the departments included in this research
- The discussion could benefit from including information about university mental health services, and how they can best operate to help meet the MH needs of students
