In general this was an interesting and well-written article. However, there are a few areas in which this paper could be improved before publication. For example:

- The introduction is quite long and repetitive, e.g. there were several uses of the phrase 'it was reported' it could be made more concise in areas. It would also be useful to see some stats on the prevalence of mental health problems in students
- I would like to see more detail on how the qualitative analysis was conducted e.g. were themes decided collaboratively by members of the research team?
- · You include information identifying the University in the table outlining the departments included in this research
- The discussion could benefit from including information about university mental health services, and how they can best operate to help meet the MH needs of students
