The paper is not well structured. Objectives are not clear enough and the process followed to achieve the objectives is very vague. However, the paper is potentially of great interest, but it needs major revisions to allow for publishing. Below, I provided some additional comments.

## **Abstract**

The abstract is too long, and it seems more an introduction than a summary of the paper. Please, revise it, accordingly. You should put more emphasis on the interplay between environmental policies and development plans. You state you use economic modelling, but I do no see any modelling in the paper.

It is hard to follow the entire paragraph. Sometimes there are repetitions and the information provided are often redundant. It might be appropriate to make a synthesis of the strategy, possibly, reducing the use of bullet points. Then, it might be worth to have an additional explanation of the instruments put in place by the Turkish government to pursue the different objectives.

Also here, so information are already provided in the former paragraph. Too many bullet points.
