Major Strengths

- The literature review is inadequate and lacks depth.
- The presentation of data, particularly regarding participants and statistical results, needs improvement.

Specific Recommendations

To enhance the quality of the manuscript, the authors are advised to:

- Develop a robust theoretical framework that aligns with the study's constructs.
- Clearly differentiate between technologies (blockchain, AI) and products (cryptocurrency) to avoid flawed comparisons.
- Refine hypotheses to clearly establish causal relationships.
- Conduct a comprehensive literature review, citing relevant studies and providing a clear rationale for participant selection.
- Improve the presentation of data by providing detailed information about participants and summarizing statistical results effectively.

• Consider incorporating suggestions from Reviewers 2 and 3 regarding the structure of the abstract, tables, and figures.

While the paper demonstrates potential, it requires significant revisions to address the identified shortcomings. By incorporating the suggested improvements, the authors can strengthen the paper's theoretical foundation, enhance the clarity of their research questions, and improve the overall quality of the manuscript.
