As mentioned in the article Municipal Boundaries: A Model of Solution "Municipal delimitation is a multidimensional problem, within which geography is one of its components, but it also includes economic, political and population factors that must also be analyzed, considering in the same way the characteristics of the neighboring municipalities that are being studied" (Bautista Andalón, Campos Cornejo, Gómez Mora, & Levine Gutiérrez, 2017, p. 98).
