- 1. Why does the author introduce the review with Diabetic Foot Ulcer? Mention the importance of Ganoderma species in the treatment of Diabetic Foot Ulcer.
- 2. It lacks an abstract summarizing the main results and showing the general conclusions.
- 3. Why have more recent results on the antibacterial activity of some Ganoderma species not been included in this review?
- 4. The focus is on antibacterial activity, so the author should present the main results in tables to make the paper more descriptive and clear.
- 5. Grammar and spelling mistakes remain and may need to be reviewed in detail.

Overall, I think this paper could potentially be suitable for publication in Qeios after a minor revision, and I hope my comments will help the author to improve their manuscript and get it published.

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
