

Review of: "Systematic Review on Effective Psychotherapies And/or Combined Treatments With Patients With Severe and Comorbidity"

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

Keywords: Except the term “psychopathology,” the rest of the keywords are not indexed in the Thesaurus. For “combined treatments,” which is not indexed, the Thesaurus offers “Combined modality therapy” instead.

Introduction: There are 4 references from the years 2010-2019. I suggest adding more references, as current as possible.

Inclusion criteria: The authors don't explicitly state the design/type of articles to be included in the review.

Exclusion criteria: “Do not meet the inclusion criteria” is not necessary, as the exclusion criteria can never be the opposite of the inclusion criteria.

Methods: The authors should provide an assessment of the methodological quality of the articles found in the searches. This assessment needs to be done by more than one reviewer.

Results: Showing the results in different tables makes understanding more difficult. I suggest unifying the results in a single table.

The authors didn't develop a Discussion section, which is probably the most important part of any article, as it is the only section that allows for objective and qualitative reasoning for every finding related to the expected outcomes.

In general, the article addresses an interesting idea, but it needs major improvements.
