The research questions need to be clarified.

Some statements would require empirical substantiation, such as "Vietnam's religious prisoners have increased during the past decade."

The article has material to become a scholarly article that may be necessary to learn about the religious situation in Vietnam. If the author can improve it, it would be a good contribution.
