- 2. The diagnoses made for these 271 patients were mainly based on clinical history and examination, which may not provide an accurate diagnosis. I would therefore suggest to add all the limitations for this observational study in the 'Discussion' section.
- 3. I would also suggest to add another heading 'Conclusion' for this manuscript.
