- While the paper introduces ethical concerns, it should delve deeper into the potential consequences of misuse and provide concrete recommendations for addressing these risks. Additionally, more focus on current solutions to privacy concerns would strengthen the discussion.
- Proofreading is necessary to correct typos, grammatical errors, and ensure that the writing flows more smoothly between sections.
