The authors offer perspectives on the increasing adoption of EVs, leading to a shift in focus towards ensuring the lasting sustainability of electric vehicle operations on a global scale.

This article demonstrates commendable writing, a coherent structure, and a seamless flow, effectively addressing key concerns related to electric vehicles. The references provided are satisfactory. Nevertheless, in its capacity as an academic article, it lacks empirical research—both qualitative, involving in-depth interviews with EV owners, dealers, and industry experts, and quantitative, encompassing comprehensive surveys among representative groups such as early EV adopters or the early majority. Absent these empirical research components, the paper contributes minimally to the current knowledge landscape and can be perceived more as an opinion piece, a perspective article, or an extensive newspaper feature rather than a scholarly work.
