To the publisher, The theoretical portion of the study paper is strong, and the research issue is significant for developing architectural competency, but I have a few observations.

It is necessary to condense the theoretical portion.

It's unclear what the measurement and study methods are.

There may be some subjectivity and bias in the measurements, results, and conclusions as they are not objective.

I propose applying the indicators in Table 2 to several architectural offices, reporting the outcomes, and thereafter identifying the areas of strength and weakness using a survey or other research techniques.

It is a good paper for publishing.
