While the questions addressed by the manuscript are important, the current version of the paper does not contribute any novel insights to the field. It reads more like a summary of previous institutional reports, and its contributions need to be articulated in a clearer and more explicit manner.

The abstract is excessively long. Instead of merely summarizing the introduction, it should provide a concise overview of the research's aim, findings, and methodology.

The labeling of the figures is unclear, and it is essential to include the source of the figures and tables beneath them. The author should clarify whether the images are his own elaborations or sourced from elsewhere.

A significant number of claims, arguments, and information presented in the manuscript lack proper citations to the sources.

The manuscript lacks a conclusion where the main findings and shortcomings of the present study should be discussed.

The structural clarity of the manuscript could be significantly improved.
