I read the manuscript and found it exciting and well-organized. However, when I tried to review the manuscript, I identified some points valuing attention for improvement. Therefore, I offer the following suggestions under different headings to improve the quality of your work:

Title

For me, it is better to use hyperlipidemia rather than high lipid profile.

Abstract

The expression "Dyslipidemia medication" is not clear to me, so other readers will also be confused, and it might be good if restated.

According to my point of view, the country/city where the study was conducted must be listed in the key words rather than putting "cross-sectional."

Background

The objective and significance of the study are not clearly stated for the readers.

Method

'This research is cross-sectional. The data is taken from medical records.' Don't you think about the controversiality of the idea?

The participants who were and were not included in the study are somewhat confusing me, and it is better to state it

clearly.

For me, it will be better if you mention the type of kit that was used to analyze glycosylated hemoglobin to indicate whether the result is standardized.

Results

As I see, there are some points that need re-writing. It might be difficult to understand, and that will lead to misunderstanding of the whole manuscript.

To Conclude

The manuscript is very thought-provoking and valuable for the scientific world. Therefore, I would like to recommend my positive ideas for this work. However, it better incorporates different points and corrects some errors given from different reviewers. There must also be consistency while writing throughout your work.
