Thanks to the author for choosing a practical and important issue. As a matter of fact, sexual relationships and education are very common concerns among adolescents in all societies around the globe. The overall presentation of the data is good; however, the manuscript should be improved in different sections based on the following comments:

- 1. In the abstract, the time and the city or location of the study should be mentioned.
- 2. Method: the sampling method, rigor of the study, selection of participants, context, place, and time of the study are unclear and should be explained clearly and completely.
- 3. It is recommended to enrich the discussion with programs or responses from similar countries or contexts to combat this social and health issue. Also, please discuss more about the cultural barriers to communication about sexual behaviors between adolescents and their parents, especially religion, which is mentioned in the results.
- 4. It seems that the conclusion could also be enriched with suggestions for more studies (qualitative or quantitative) to explore the sexual patterns of the same group but in different contexts of France, in order to provide more comprehensive evidence to social and health policy makers.
- 5. Minor English editing is also needed.
