An oral medicine used to treat *type 2 diabetes*. Miglitol slows down the digestion of foods high in *carbohydrate*, such as rice, bread, milk, and fruit. The result is a slower and lower rise in *blood glucose* after meals. Miglitol belongs to the class of medicines called *alpha-glucosidase inhibitors*. (Brand name: *Glyset*.)

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
