- The abstract section needed to include research design, contribution, and limitations.
- Several abstract sentences are repeated in the main text, e.g., 2nd para of p. 2, 1st para of p. 6, 2nd para of p. 8, etc.
- Findings from recent research related to the topic should be expressed in the introduction section. Besides, the uniqueness of the study should be mentioned here.
- Most recent literature needed to be discussed in the literature review section. Referencing style should be updated, e.g., Ningsih, S., & Permatasari, F. F. (2018).
- The study's objective is already mentioned in the introduction, so it need not be repeated.
- Table 1 and Figure 1 represent the same information. So, drop anyone (better for Table 1).
- Para 1 from p. 8, discussions and results from Table and figure are mismatched. Check it carefully.
- Identical referencing styles should be followed (either APA or Chicago).
