Authors had an interesting idea to write an article attempting to share their experience in the use of free iliac flap for maxillomandibular reconstruction. They presented a well written manuscript presenting their experience in a rational way. However, we would make some suggestions in an effort to improve the final outcome.

First, in the Result section authors did not mention how many oncological cases were include in their study. It could be better to present it. Second, in the same section it was mentioned that the vast majority of the bone defects in these series concerned the mandible and especially its body. It is suggested to write in a parenthesis the exact number along with its percentage.

The discussion section although exhaustive and interesting it includes many informations. It would be easier for the reader if authors add titles at the beginning of each paragraph.

General Statement

It is a well written manuscript that deserves to be published after the proposed minor revisions.

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
