4. It is recommended that the authors use Turnitin to check the similarity of the content generated by ChatGPT and then make a comparison, analysis, and comment on the results to confirm the validity of the results.
5. The effectiveness of ChatGPT in various disciplines is meaningful for how to comment to help check the reliability of the results.
6. There is a lack of citations in relevant journal papers, so expect more people to integrate into the research.
