

Review of: "Rush Farming of Konjac (Amorphophallus Muelleri) Among Novice Farmers In West Java, Indonesia: A Descriptive Study"

This work aims to enrich the discourse of the konjac business by determining the type of konjac cultivation and the economic benefits for farmers by looking at the business feasibility of konjac cultivation.

In this study, 37 farmers were interviewed. In addition, data about framing patterns, government policies related to konjac culture, and the konjac phenomenon for well-being were also analyzed descriptively. The commercial value of konjac was calculated by analyzing costs, revenues, net income, and the benefit-cost ratio.

Based on the results presented, I consider that the work achieved its objectives and should be accepted for publication. The conclusions are interesting, although deeper analyzes of technical, logistical and market aspects would be necessary to increase the precision and accuracy of the recommendations.
