

Review of: "SECURE II: Unlocking the Potential of Artificial Intelligence for Entrepreneurial Success"

- 1. The authors deserve appreciation for their nearly exhaustive style of presentation.
- 2. It is recommended that the authors provide the keywords in synchronization with the words used in the abstract and remaining text of the manuscript.
- 3. The corresponding long forms should accompany all the first usages of abbreviations (in abstract and the remaining manuscript). At the same location, the words of the long form should be suitably written in Title Case. Either the style of 'long form followed by the abbreviation' (preferably) or the 'abbreviation followed by the long form' should be consistently used throughout the manuscript. After the abbreviation has been defined at the first instance, the subsequent text of the manuscript should not unnecessarily mention the abbreviation and long form again, and rather only the abbreviation should be used. 'Artificial Intelligence (AI)' is just to exemplify for a phrase which has been inconsistently and redundantly used.
- 4. In the second paragraph of the Introduction section, a starting double quote is missing while the closing is there. Also, it is recommended that the authors use either the format of double quotes or italics (but not a combination of these two) throughout the text consistently.
- 5. Correction needed for the usage: 'the'
- 6. The authors claim that the participants were from three countries. It is recommended that the authors provide sufficient metadata in form of the exact number of respondents from each country as well as the total number of respondents.
- 7. All the figures with graphical content need to have captions for both axes in addition to the labels for the axes.
- 8. All redundant in-figure titles need to be removed, as the figures already have the necessary titles below them.
- 9. All figures and tables should be cited only by their respective numbers and without reference to accompanying/non-accompanying words like 'above' and 'below'. Ideally, it is recommended that the authors verify the entire manuscript for compliance of this.
- 10. It is recommended that the authors use the word 'F1' instead of the word 'F' value/score/etc.
- 11. The code snippet is not recommended to be included in the manuscript.
- 12. It is suggested that the authors explicitly answer the questions (initially framed) towards the end sections of the manuscript.
- 13. There are a lot of references from arXiv. In order to maintain quality, it is recommended that the authors prefer citing only the duly reviewed, accepted, and published research work. At least, the reference corresponding to the peer-reviewed published version of the arXiv paper should be included wherever possible.
